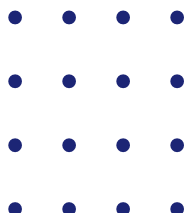

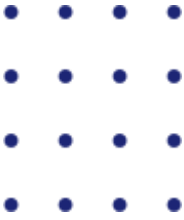

You will Embark On a wonderful private scenic tour of the Cape Peninsula to The Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point.

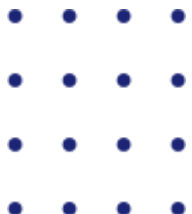
The route takes us through Clifton Beach, Camps Bay, The 12 Apostles, Hout Bay, and the beautiful Chapman's Peak drive.

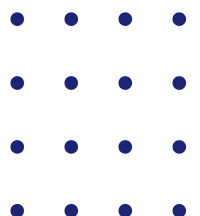
At only 1.5km square, Langa is one of the smallest townships in the city.

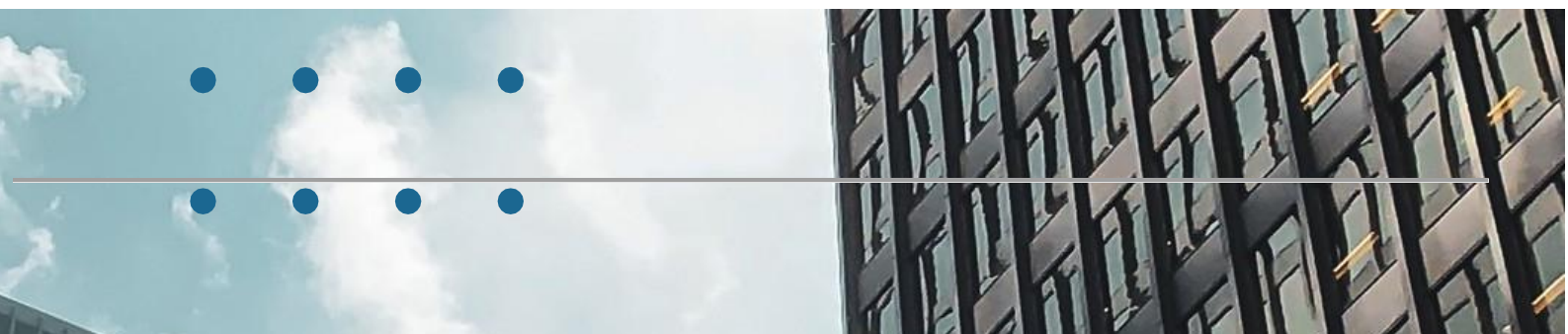
